NOTICE ON CHURCH ATTORNEY'S MOTION FOR SANCTIONS

On Monday, November 6, 2023, the Church Attorney filed a Motion for Sanctions (hereinafter "MOTION") with the Hearing Panel that in part states the "Church Attorney has just learned that the Respondent has communicated with various individuals who are potential witnesses concerning activities in this case."

In accordance with Canon IV.13.7 Respondent shall have 15 days from the filing of the MOTION to file written response.


For the Hearing Panel to promptly set a hearing date to allow the parties to present oral arguments as to the MOTION (Canon IV.13.7), Respondent's Counsel and the Church Attorney are to communicate their availabilities for a hearing date on the MOTION by email to the Hearing Panel.

To provide necessary time for consideration and ruling on the MOTION, the Hearing Panel at this time anticipates that the December 12, 2023,

date set in the September 5, 2023, DISCOVERY AND SCHEDULE ORDER for beginning the Hearing Panel proceeding in this matter may need to be reset. The Hearing Panel will address possible resetting of the date for the beginning of the Hearing Panel proceeding at the time of ruling on the MOTION.
